

2022-2023 Sharing Hat

Worsted Beanie



Skills needed:

- Long tail cast on, increasing, Knit 2 Together decrease
- Circular knitting

Materials:

- 2 oz (approx. 55 grams) worsted weight yarn

Needles:

- 32" Size 8 **or** 9 circular for magic loop
OR
- 16" Size 8 **or** 9 circular and matching DPN

Gauge:

- Not critical: if it's too small or too large, it will fit SOMEBODY.

Instructions:

Cast on 80 stitches using Long Tail Cast On

Body of Hat Pattern:

Row 1: K1, P1, repeat around.

Row 2: Knit around.

Repeat these 2 rows until hat is 7" from cast on edge.

Crown Decrease:

Place markers every 10 stitches. (You should have eight sections.)

Decrease Row: *Knit until last 2 st before marker, Knit 2 tog, slip marker*, repeat between ** around.

Repeat this row until you have 1 stitch between markers.

Cut yarn with 8" tail. Using a darning needle, pull the tail through the loops. Weave in ends. If you wish, wet block your hat, dry over a head form, balloon, or flat.

Completed hats can be dropped off at Yarn Over (59 College Rd)

The hats will be collected by The Bread Line and shared with someone who needs a warm hat.
